My Dear People,

Today's theme on the Readings: THIS IS THE HOLY TRINITY

Today we celebrate the Holy Trinity, one of the most confounding mysteries of our faith. Through this mystery we experience our relationship to God: Creator, Savior, and Holy Spirit. This relationship is not easy to understand or to describe. It does not become clearer through analysis. Its complexity mirrors the complexity of all our relationships. We understand our relationships with our spouses, our children, our parents, and our friends only through daily give-and-take, annual rituals, and the life-changing moments we share. We understand our relationships only as we live them. The relationships we have with those we love, and who love us, sustain us through an uncertain and difficult life. This is the Holy Trinity.

What is striking about today's readings is that each is incomplete. What they do offer is a description of a moment in our relationship, a memory of a time and an event when our relationship made sense even though that sense may be beyond our ability to describe fully. Often that is all that our faith offers, that is, a memory of what is possible, what is promised, what has been given. A memory of eternity, of love beyond understanding is to be cherished and nurtured even if not fully understood. This is the Holy Trinity.

These outstanding graduates are congratulated on their accomplishments and wished much success as they pursue their future educational goals.

On June 12th and 13th, three relics were on display at STM, with escort and security provided by the Knights of Columbus. The relics are on pilgrimage, throughout the Diocese, to Christ Cathedral where they will be placed in the permanent altar prior to the dedication on July 17th. The three relics are:

North American Martyrs

St. John de Brébeuf, St. Charles Garnier and **St. Gabriel Lalemant (his relic was displayed)** were French Jesuit priests who lived and worked among the Native American tribes in Canada and upstate New York in the 17th Century. They were killed during conflict between the warring tribes of the Iroquois Confederacy. They were canonized as martyrs by Pope Pius XI in 1930. Along with 5 other Jesuit missionaries killed in Canada and upstate New York between 1642 and 1649, they are known collectively as the North American Martyrs. Their relics were obtained by Msgr. Stephen Doktorczyk, vicar general for the Diocese of Orange, who corresponded with officials from the Jesuits USA Northeast Province, in New York City.

St. Rafael Guízar y Valencia

St. Rafael Guízar y Valencia was a Mexican Catholic bishop who lived in the late 19th and early 20th Century. He was known for caring for the sick and wounded during the Mexican Revolution. During the revolution, he continued his work as a priest despite facing intense persecution and was forced to flee to Cuba. After the revolution he returned to Mexico, and continued his ministry to the poor and infirmed until his death in 1938. St. Rafael Guízar y Valencia was canonized in October 2015 by Pope Benedict XVI.

St. Andrew Dũng-Lạc was a Vietnamese priest in the 19th century who was persecuted and killed for his spiritual beliefs. He was among 117 Catholics martyred in Vietnam between 1820-1862. The relic, a bone from the saint's hand, was gifted to the Diocese of Orange by Pierre Cardinal Nguyễn Văn Nhơn of the Archdiocese of Hanoi. Rev. John Francis Vu, Catholic chaplain at the University of California, Irvine, travelled to Hanoi in November to accept the relic from Cardinal Nguyen. Cardinal Nguyen handed Rev. Vu the relic at the cardinal's private residence near the cathedral. Early the next morning, Cardinal Nguyen received word that Pope Francis accepted the retirement the Cardinal had submitted 5 ½ years earlier, effective at noon Rome time that very day. Gifting the relic to the Diocese of Orange was Cardinal Nguyen's final official act before retirement.

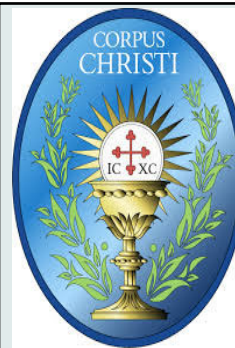

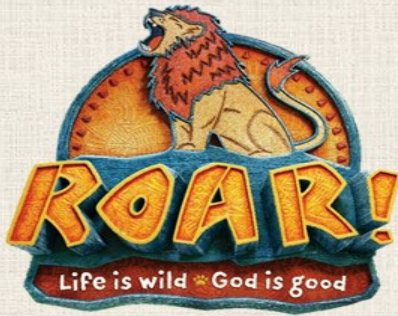


**Corpus Christi Procession
Sun., June 23rd
After the Spanish Mass**

Corpus Christi will be celebrated next Sun. June 23rd. It is the Latin name for the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. The feast honors the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the

Holy Eucharist – Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. This is the essence of our Catholic Mass.

On Sunday June 23rd, Fr Justice will revive a popular tradition that dates back to the Middle Ages. He will lead a solemn Eucharistic procession immediately after the 2:15 pm Spanish/English Mass. 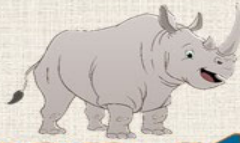

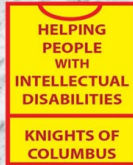

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Today's feast, extending a dimension of Easter joy into Ordinary Time, reminds us that every aspect of worship centers on the mystery of God in three persons. At baptism, we are initiated into Christ *and* the Spirit. The Creed we recite at Mass every Sunday has its roots in the ancient celebration of baptism, when a new believer was questioned at the edge of the waters of the font with three questions: Do you believe in God, the Father, the Son, the Holy Spirit? Three questions, three affirmations, three immersions into the saving waters. Because every liturgy abounds with references to the Trinity, not only in words but in blessings by the sign of the cross, this feast was not easily accepted into the calendar. Pope Alexander in the eleventh century remarked that the liturgy is so laden with praise of the Trinity that there was no need for a special feast. Two hundred years later, while in exile in France, Pope John XXII proclaimed the feast, but it was not until 1911 that Pope St. Pius X gave it status as a solemnity.

A favorite image in art for today is the Icon of the Trinity, showing three glorious winged men seated at a table laden with bread and a cup of wine. It recalls Abraham's hospitality to angels and gives expression to the inner life of God, a life lived in relationship, a life poured out in abundance whenever Christians gather at the table of the Eucharist to give praise to the Father, in Christ, in the embrace of the Spirit. —James Field, Copyright © J. 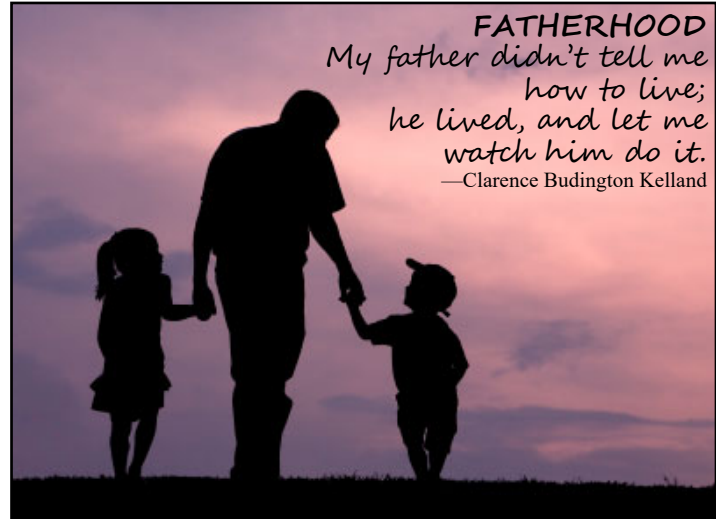

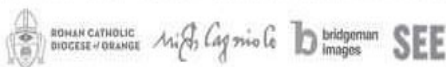
