Today's theme on the Readings: LISTEN TO JESUS AND THE PROPHETS

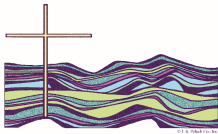

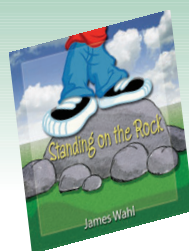
