



LETTER FROM THE PASTOR | Lent + Easter 2024

Suffering. Sin. Death. These are experiences that we often work hard to avoid but they are entrenched into our lives. Lent is a time to take a deep dive into the spirituality of suffering. But why would we want to? Because there indeed is a treasury of wisdom, virtue, power, and grace that is to be gained through our faithful and humble attendance at the School of the Cross of Jesus Christ. The Cross serves as a bullseye, the sure target of all our spirituality, for it is only in and through the Cross that we enter into salvation. Ultimately the Cross is about mercy. Mercy that forgives. Mercy that heals. Mercy that saves. Let us take our sufferings and our sins to the foot of the Cross, offering them humbly and prayerfully to our Savior. Let us faithfully pray the Stations of the Cross each Friday. Let us truly take to heart the sacrifice of refraining from meat on Fridays and fasting certain meals during the week. Let us make a resolve to explore how to pray more deeply - to see how sacrifice plays a crucial role within prayer. And then let us strive to imitate the mercy shown upon the Cross. 40 days with Jesus in the desert. 40 days to contemplate the Lord's Cross. Then we will launch into 50 days relishing in the victory of Jesus Christ over suffering, sin, and death. May you truly have a prayerful Lent so you may have a truly fulfilling and joyful Easter season.



The St Thomas More Parish Library staff would like to wish all our parishioners a Happy Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Parish Library will be open today from 9:00am to 1:00pm.

The seasons of the Catholic Church in the Roman Rite are: Advent, Christmas, Lent, Easter and Ordinary Time. The term Ordinary Time refers to the order of Sundays in the Church Liturgical Year that takes place in two parts, but is considered a single season. The season of Ordinary Time takes us through the life of Christ, the mystery of Christ, the teaching of Christ and the building-up of the kingdom of God. This journey is a time for life, re-growth and maturing in faith. The traditional color is green which is a sign of hope, rebirth and the triumph of life over death. The richness of this season is to give us the opportunity to know Christ more intimately in the everyday realities of our faith-filled life. The scripture proclaimed in this season reveals the teaching, healing and the Gospel mission of Christ. These are the days where we grow into who we are called to be by imitating the reality of the life of Jesus. Beatus Ordinarius Tempus

Question:

Is Ash Wednesday a holy day of obligation?

Answer:

Despite the often packed churches, you may be surprised to hear that the

answer is no! Holy days of obligation commemorate a particular event (such as the birth of Christ at Christmas) or celebrate particular people (such as Mary's Immaculate Conception or the feast of All Saints). Ash Wednesday is a day of penance, fasting, and abstinence to begin the season of Lent. In a sense, it focuses on a *concept* rather than something particular and concrete.

Of course, repentance ought to be reflected in particular, concrete ways! That's one of the reasons that attending Mass on Ash Wednesday is a very good idea. It marks the beginning of a solemn season of penance. Despite all its comparisons to the desert, Lent can be very fruitful for our spiritual growth! Beginning this season with the celebration of Mass and the reception of ashes is a sign of our commitment to God and to spiritual growth.

FASTING

In the dioceses in the United States, Catholics aged 18 through 59 are bound to fast on both Ash Wednesday (February 14, 2024) and Good Friday (March 29, 2024). To fast means a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Food and drink between meals (excepting water and medicine) is not permitted on fast days.

Since Ash Wednesday falls on Valentine's Day this year, some have been asking if there is a special dispensation from fasting and abstinence. The Bishops have not granted any special dispensations for Ash Wednesday this year. So, make sure to enjoy your Valentine's dinner and chocolates one day early on Fat Tuesday!

ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT

Catholics aged 14 and up are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. To abstain means refraining from eating beef, veal, pork, or poultry at least, although eggs and milk products are acceptable. The consumption of fish and shellfish is permitted, though the penitential character of the abstinence should be kept in mind.






