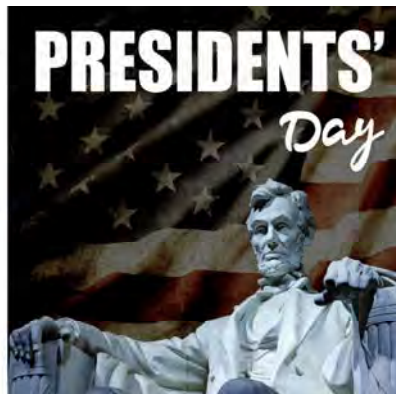

**FASTING:** In the dioceses in the United States, Catholics aged 18 through 59 are bound to fast on both **Ash Wednesday, February 18** and **Good Friday, April 3**. To *fast* means a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Food and drink (excepting water and medicine) is not permitted on fast days.

### ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT:

Catholics aged 14 and up are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. To abstain means refraining from eating beef, veal, pork, or poultry at least, although eggs and milk products are acceptable. The consumption of fish and shellfish is permitted, though the penitential character of the abstinence should be kept in mind.

# Welcome

Let us welcome Deacon David Wang to our parish. He has been assigned to be in our parish briefly until June 30 this year. Let us support him as he prepares for ordination to the priesthood.

Deacon David Wang is a transitional deacon from mainland China, raised in a traditional Catholic family with several priestly and religious vocations. After completing his undergraduate studies, he entered priestly formation, completing philosophical studies in China and continuing his theological formation in the United States.

He arrived in the United States in 2018 and pursued priestly formation at Saint Mary's Seminary and University in Baltimore, where he earned the Bachelor of Sacred Theology and the Master of Divinity degrees. He was ordained a transitional deacon on March 4, 2023. He later earned a Master of Arts in Theology from Villanova University, with a focus on faith and science.

Over the past three years, Deacon Wang has served in pastoral ministry at Saint Katharine of Siena Parish and Holy Redeemer Chinese Catholic Church in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. He is grateful to continue his vocation journey and looks forward to serving the Church in the Diocese of Orange.
