



#### The Library Corner

The STM Parish Library staff would like to wish all our parishioners a Happy 4th Sunday of Lent. The Parish Library will be open today from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm.

Have you ever had an interest in, questions of or doubts about the Catholic faith? Are you a Catholic who wants to reaffirm, renew and reconfirm your Faith? By hearing the testimony of different conversion stories to the Catholic Church we can learn more about our own Catholicism. The STM Parish Library has a great book that explains this conversion path to full communion with the Catholic Church. The name of this book is, 'Born Fundamentalist, Born Again Catholic,' written by David B. Currie. David addresses the main doctrines that separate Protestants and Catholics and he explains some of the major obstacles that help support Protestant biases. The author illustrates his inner burning for a closer relationship with Christ and where the Truth led him to a one, holy, Catholic and apostolic Church. (CTA)

Today, the Catholic Church will celebrate Laetare Sunday which marks the half-way point of Lent. Laetare means to Rejoice, expressing our belief in the hope of the resurrection and to inspire us as we continue our Lenten commitments of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Traditionally, priests will celebrate this joy by wearing the pink/rose colored vestments.


FASTING In the dioceses in the United States, Catholics aged 18 through 59 are bound to fast on both Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, March 29th. To *fast* means a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Food and drink between meals (excepting water and medicine) is not permitted on fast days.

#### ABSTINENCE FROM

MEAT Catholics aged 14 and up are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. To abstain means refraining from eating beef, veal, pork, or poultry at least, although eggs and milk products are acceptable. The consumption of fish and shellfish is permitted, though the penitential character of the abstinence

should be

kept in mind.


