
#### Second Reading:



FASTING In the dioceses in the United States, Catholics aged 18 through 59 are bound to fast on both Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, April 18th. To *fast* means a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Food and drink between meals (excepting water and medicine) is not permitted on fast days.

ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT Catholics aged 14 and up are to

abstain from meat on Ash
Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and
Good Friday. To abstain means
refraining from eating beef, veal,
pork, or poultry at least, although
eggs and milk products are
acceptable. The consumption of fish
and shellfish is permitted, though the
penitential character of the
abstinence should be kept in mind.






