Today's theme on the readings: DIFFICULTY, SURVIVAL, AND GLORY

In Revelation, John the Evangelist tells us what we can expect as followers of the risen Jesus: distress, endurance, and a kingdom. Although we are only eight days into our fifty-day Easter feasting, we cannot ignore the distress weighing down our daily lives. Jesus' resurrection does not erase individual suffering, but his glorious triumph over death cultivates endurance in our hearts. We remember that Jesus did not spare himself, and we ask for the strength to endure as he did. Imitating Christ helps us grow as members of God's royal family. As beloved citizens of the Kingdom of God, we recognize our kinship with all people. Peter demonstrates his care for others as he heals multitudes of broken, suffering people. In the Gospel, Thomas accepts his own spiritual healing when Jesus helps him to believe. In times of difficulty, survival, and glory, we borrow Thomas' declaration of faith: "My Lord and my God!" The Library Corner

Divine Mercy Sunday



The St Thomas More Parish Library staff would like to wish all our parishioners a Happy Divine Mercy Sunday. The Parish Library will be open today from 9:00am to 1:00pm.

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Divine Mercy of Christ. Pope John Paul II established this feast day on April 30, 2000. Jesus to Sister Faustina and requested that a special novena be said, a picture be painted according to His vision and a chaplet be recited at the Hour of Great Mercy.

The parish library has a great book on this topic titled, 'Divine Mercy', authored by Robert Stockpole. Robert states that Divine Mercy is God's love reaching down to meet the needs and overcome the miseries of His People. As Catholics, we know that the Lord's Divine Mercy is a love that is steadfast, always giving, tender and compassionate.

Let us sing forever for the Lord's Divine Mercy.

Devotion to the Divine Mercy

In the Jubilee Year of 2000, Pope John Paul II proclaimed that the Second Sunday of Easter be call "Divine Mercy Sunday". He also strongly encouraged the whole, universal Church, to heed the messages and revelations Jesus has given to St. Faustina in *The Diary of St. Faustina*. This special call for our time is to turn back to God and the "F.I.N.C.H" are helpful means to that end.

When we approach to receive Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday, we are approaching the divine floodgates where He will give us the "Extraordinary Graces" of complete forgiveness (remission) of sins and punishment, if we are in a state of grace. Jesus promised us this "Extraordinary Grace" to emphasize the infinite value of **Confession and Communion** as miracles of mercy.

The Eucharist is the divine floodgates where all graces flow.

Remember F.I.N.C.H

F = Feast of Divine Mercy Sunday. Jesus promised to give "Extraordinary Graces" on this day, which is equivalent to the *complete renewal of baptismal grace* or complete forgiveness of sins and punishment, in addition to the plenary indulgence (Diary #699).

I = Image. Venerate the image of Jesus with the signature: "Jesus, I trust in You." The more a soul trusts in His Mercy, the more it will receive (Diary #1578).

N = Novena. The nine days of the Divine Mercy Novena has specific set of intentions to offer and *begins on Good Friday* (Diary #1209-1228, #796).

C = Chaplet. The Divine Mercy Chaplet is prayed on ordinary Rosary beads. Jesus promised that those who pray the Chaplet will receive great mercy at the hour of death (Diary #474-476, #687).

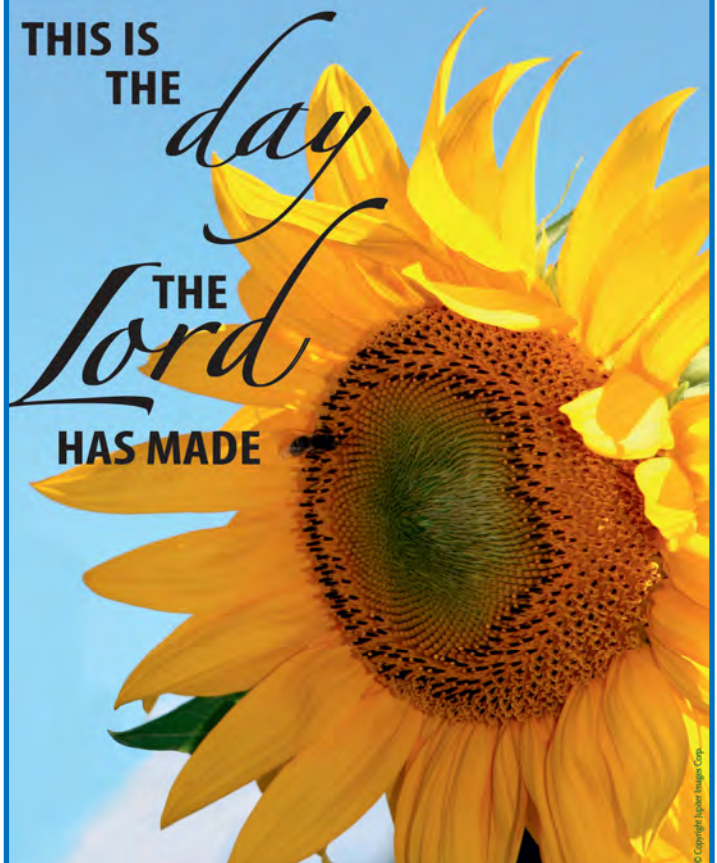
H = Hour. Jesus died on the Cross for us at 3 pm, every day between 3 and 4 in the afternoon is known as the Hour of Great Mercy. At this hour you can obtain everything for yourself and for others for the asking (Diary #1572).

SUGGESTED PLENARY INDULGENCE OF THE MONTH APRIL 2022



ADORATION OF THE CROSS

A **PLENARY INDULGENCE** is granted the **Christian faithful who devoutly take part in the adoration of the cross during the solemn liturgy of Good Friday.**

FR. EUGENE'S COMMENTARY & SUGGESTION

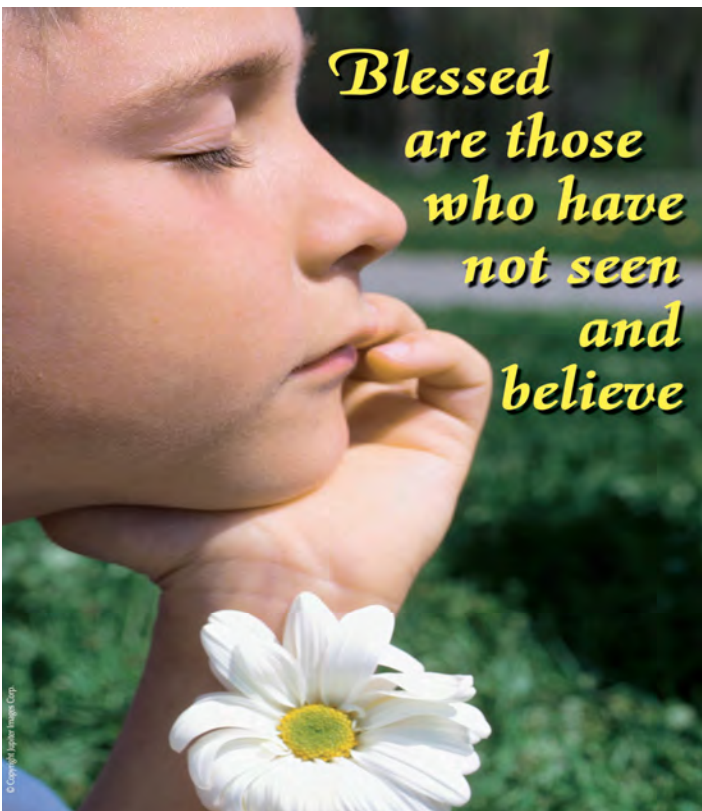
Here at St. Thomas More Catholic Church we will have Good Friday liturgy on April 15 at 3:00 pm and at 7:00 pm. There is hardly any other day on our calendar that holds more significance than this solemn day in which we remember the awful price that was paid for our salvation.

CONDITIONS FOR RECEIVING A PLENARY INDULGENCE

1. Do the prescribed work.
2. Receive Holy Communion within several days (before or after) of the indulgenced act.
3. Go to confession within several days (before or after) the indulgenced act
4. Pray for the Pope. An Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be can suffice.
5. Be free from attachment to all sin, even venial sin.
6. OTHER NOTES: · In order to be capable of gaining indulgences one must be baptized, not excommunicated, and in the state of grace (free of mortal sin) at least at the completion of the prescribed works. · To gain an indulgence, one must have at least the general intention of doing so and must carry out the enjoined works at the stated time and in due fashion, according to the sense of the grant. · Plenary indulgences can be applied to one's self, or to a person who has died. · Only one plenary indulgence may be obtained per day. · A single sacramental confession suffices for gaining several plenary indulgences; but Holy Communion must be received and prayer for the intention of the Holy Father must be recited for the gaining of each plenary indulgence. · Special exceptions can always be made for those who are sick or disabled in which case please inquire with the priest.

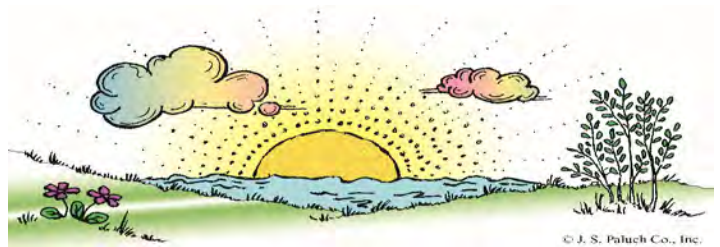
