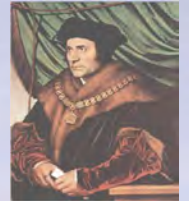

**TODAY'S READINGS**

**First Reading** — Paul and Barnabas continue their travels, spreading the faith and unifying the churches (Acts 14:21-27).  
**Psalm** — I will praise your name for ever, my king and my God (Psalm 145).  
**Second Reading** — John's vision of God dwelling with the human race (Revelation 21:1-5a).  
**Gospel** — As Jesus has loved us, so we must love one another (John 13:31-33a, 34-35).

**Today's theme on the readings MAKING ALL THINGS NEW**

Although we are five full weeks into the celebration of Easter, today's readings focus on newness. Our Easter food leftovers may be long gone, but the readings insist on every moment's freshness in the risen Jesus. The Acts of the Apostles depicts Paul and Barnabas reflecting on all the innovative work that God has done with them. They have traveled hundreds of miles, introducing faith in Jesus Christ to all who listen, even Gentiles. For the dutiful Jewish scholar Paul, preaching to Gentiles is a completely unique development. Jesus calls Paul, and us, not to be afraid of new challenges: as John the Evangelist reports in Revelation, Jesus promises to "make all things new." In the Gospel reading, Jesus even gives us a new commandment. The Hebrew Scriptures overflow with commandments, but Jesus knows we need one more, perfect mission: "love one another." Copyright © J. 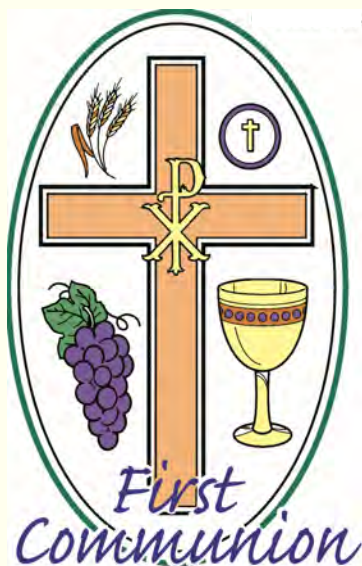
### The Library Corner

Fifth Sunday of Easter



The St. Thomas More Parish Library staff would like to wish all our parishioners a Happy Fifth Sunday of Easter. The Parish Library will be open today from 9:00am to 1:00pm.

Today, I would like to talk about our Lord's total sacrifice for us. Jesus humbled himself into the likeness of man. He was persecuted, scourged, died on the cross, and was resurrected for our salvation. This type of service and sacrifice is being repeated time and time again by lay people and priests all over the world. The Parish Library has a great book on this topic titled, '*The Grunt Padre*', authored by Father Daniel L. Mode. The Grunt Padre is about Father Vincent Robert Capodanno. Father Vincent was a military chaplain serving in Vietnam 1966-1967 as a front-line chaplain. He chose to move with the Marines on missions, to help with the wounded and give last rites when desired. While trying to shield a wounded marine, he died on the battlefield. As a result of his service and sacrifice, he was awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor.

## SUGGESTED PLENARY INDULGENCE OF THE MONTH MAY 2022

### PRAYERS TO THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

A PLENARY INDULGENCE is granted the Christian faithful who

1. devoutly recite the Marian rosary in a church or oratory, or in a family, a religious community, or an association of the faithful, and in general when several of the faithful gather for some honest purpose;
2. devoutly join in the recitation of the rosary while it is being recited by the Supreme Pontiff and broadcast live by radio or television.

### FR. EUGENE'S COMMENTARY & SUGGESTION

May is the Month of Mary. Here at St. Thomas More Catholic Church we pray the rosary Monday to Saturday after the 8 am Mass. We will also have a "Mary's Night" on Friday, May 13 (the Memorial of Our Lady of Fatima) beginning with Holy Hour at 6 pm. During Mary's Night we will honor in a special way the Queen of Heaven and we will pray the Rosary. Families are especially encouraged to attend this beautiful evening, and most especially families are urged to pray the Rosary together frequently.

### CONDITIONS FOR RECEIVING A PLENARY INDULGENCE

1. Do the prescribed work.
2. Receive Holy Communion within several days (before or after) of the indulgenced act.
3. Go to confession within several days (before or after) the indulgenced act
4. Pray for the Pope. An Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be can suffice.
5. Be free from attachment to all sin, even venial sin.
6. OTHER NOTES: • In order to be capable of gaining indulgences one must be baptized, not excommunicated, and in the state of grace (free of mortal sin) at least at the completion of the prescribed works. • To gain an indulgence, one must have at least the general intention of doing so and must carry out the enjoined works at the stated time and in due fashion, according to the sense of the grant. • Plenary indulgences can be applied to one's self, or to a person who has died. • Only one plenary indulgence may be obtained per day. • A single sacramental confession suffices for gaining several plenary indulgences; but Holy Communion must be received and prayer for the intention of the Holy Father must be recited for the gaining of each plenary indulgence. • Special exceptions can always be made for those who are sick or disabled in which case please inquire with the priest.

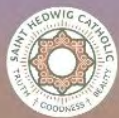
