





If you are looking for fullness with the Lord and how God calls you to become who you were created to be, then the STM Parish Library has a great book for you. The name of this book is, 'The Story of Ruth,' and the author is a Benedictine nun and theologian, Sister Joan D. Chittister. Sister Joan leads you through the Biblical story of Ruth and Naomi as they meet their challenges. She relates their experience to the challenges that face all women, especially as women continue to struggle with inequality and stereotypical limitations. 






Saint of the week



First Reading:


