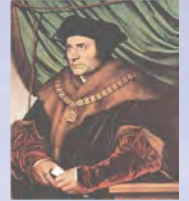

The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus will be celebrated this year on Friday June 24th.

The novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus will be recited daily immediately following the 8:00 am Mass starting on Thursday, June 16th and ending on the Solemnity, Friday, June 24th, except for Sunday June 19th (please pray at home).

This novena was given to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque by Jesus Christ to His Sacred Heart. It is said that St. Padre Pio recited this novena daily for all those who requested his prayers. This novena can be prayed at any time, though it is a tradition to begin on the traditional feast of Corpus Christi (Thursday after Trinity Sunday) leading up to the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Today's theme on the readings: BIBLICAL ROOTS OF THE TRINITY

Today's readings show some biblical roots of what Christians would later call the Trinity. Proverbs showcases the role of Wisdom in the work of creation, portrayed as a reality outside of God but integrated into God's work of forming the heavens and the earth. We join the psalmist in sharing Wisdom's delight in God's handiwork: "O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth" (Psalm 8:2). In his letter to the Romans, Paul writes of peace with God through Jesus, and the love of God received through the Holy Spirit, distinguishing God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit while also displaying their abiding unity. Finally, in the farewell discourse from John's Gospel, Jesus—who had earlier spoken of himself as Son of the Father—promises his friends that they will receive the Spirit of truth that will teach and guide them after his departure. Most Holy Trinity Sunday



The St Thomas More Parish Library staff would like to wish all our parishioners a Happy Most Holy Trinity Sunday. The Parish Library will be open today from 9:00am to 1:00pm.

Today the Catholic Church will honor the feast of the Holy Trinity. This special feast was approved by Pope John XXII in 1334 for the entire Church. As Catholics, we remember the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and followers and the doctrine of our faith of the three persons of God; the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

SUGGESTED PLENARY INDULGENCE OF THE MONTH JUNE 2022

ACT OF REPARATION TO THE SACRED HEART

A partial indulgence is granted the Christian faithful who devoutly recite the above act of reparation. This indulgence will be a plenary one when this Act of Reparation is publicly recited on the solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The prayer is as follows:

Most loving Jesus, how great is the love which you have poured out upon the world. How casual and careless is our response! Kneeling before you, we wish to atone for the indifference and the slights which pierce you to the heart.

R). *Praise to the heart of Jesus, our Savior and our God.*

We ask forgiveness for our own shameful neglect. We wish to make amends for those who are obstinate in their unbelief, for those who turn away from the light and wander like sheep without a shepherd, and for those who have broken their baptismal promises and reject the gentle yoke of your law. R).

We wish to make amends for the sins of our society:

for lust and degradation, for the corruption of the young,

for indifference and blasphemy,

for attacks against your Church,

for irreverence and even sacrilege against Your love in the Blessed Sacrament, and for the public defiance of your law. R).

These are the sins for which you died, but now we share in your atonement by offering on the altar in union with you the living sacrifice you made on the cross, joining to it the sufferings of your Virgin Mother and those of all the saints and the whole church. R).

We promise faithfully, that by your grace we shall make reparation for our own sins, and for those of others by a strong faith, by holy living, and by obedience to the law of the Gospel, whose greatest commandment is that of charity. R).

We also promise to do our best to discourage others from insulting you and bring those we can to follow you. R).

Jesus Lord, receive this loving act of homage together with the prayers of our Lady, who stood by the cross, our model in reparation. Keep us faithful, even to the point of death, give us the gift of perseverance and lead us all to our promised land in heaven, where you, with the Father and the Holy Spirit, live and reign for ever and ever. Amen. R).



FR. EUGENE'S COMMENTARY & SUGGESTION

The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus will be on Friday, June 24. On this day, here at STM, during our 6:00 pm Friday Holy Hour, we will have an opportunity to pray this Act of Reparation. Pope Pius XII described this devotion as follows: "It is altogether impossible to enumerate the heavenly gifts which devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus has poured out on the souls of the faithful, purifying them, offering them heavenly strength, rousing them to the attainment of all virtues.

Therefore, recalling those wise words of the Apostle St. James, 'Every best gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of Lights,'" ("Haurietis Aquas: On Devotion to the Sacred Heart").

CONDITIONS FOR RECEIVING A PLENARY INDULGENCE

1. Do the prescribed work.
2. Receive Holy Communion within several days (before or after) of the indulgenced act.
3. Go to confession within several days (before or after) the indulgenced act
4. Pray for the Pope. An Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be can suffice.
5. Be free from attachment to all sin, even venial sin.
6. OTHER NOTES: · In order to be capable of gaining indulgences one must be baptized, not excommunicated, and in the state of grace (free of mortal sin) at least at the completion of the prescribed works. · To gain an indulgence, one must have at least the general intention of doing so and must carry out the enjoined works at the stated time and in due fashion, according to the sense of the grant. · Plenary indulgences can be applied to one's self, or to a person who has died. · Only one plenary indulgence may be obtained per day. · A single sacramental confession suffices for gaining several plenary indulgences; but Holy Communion must be received and prayer for the intention of the Holy Father must be recited for the gaining of each plenary indulgence. · Special exceptions can always be made for those who are sick or disabled in which case please inquire with the priest.
