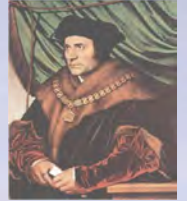

Reflection question:

How am I part of the Body of Christ in the world?



Today's theme on the readings: THE GIFT OF THE EUCHARIST

Today we hear how Abram encounters Melchizedek, "king of Salem . . . and a priest of God Most High" (Genesis 14:18). Melchizedek appears nowhere else in scripture, but is nonetheless significant. Psalm 110 declares of the great King David, "You are a priest forever, in the line of Melchizedek," a description later given (in the letter to the Hebrews) to Christ as High Priest. Early Christians saw in Melchizedek's bread and wine the bread and wine of the Eucharist; Paul's account of the Last Supper (in today's second reading) is the oldest one in scripture. In the Gospel, Luke describes Jesus providing bread for a crowd in words similar to Paul's, words still used by the Church: Jesus takes bread, gives thanks, breaks it. Together, these three readings reveal how Christian priesthood, Christ's Real Presence, and the call to serve those in need are all found in the gift of the Eucharist. Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ
Corpus Christi Sunday



The St. Thomas More Parish Library staff would like to wish all our parishioners a Happy Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ Sunday. Happy Father's Day to all our fathers!

The Parish Library will not be open today.

The Catholic Church will celebrate today the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. Pope Urban IV ordered the Church to hold its first Feast of Corpus Christi in 1264. This festival of the Church honors the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. The Parish Library has a great book on the life and times of Jesus in the Gospels titled, *'To know Christ Jesus'*, authored by Frank Sheed. Sheed presents an intimate knowledge of Jesus through the history and geography of His times and also provides the larger context of life way back then, by filling in the details. The author's concern with the Gospels is to help us to know Christ as he actually lived among us, interacted with all the various people He encountered from His infancy to His passion and death and to realize how they acknowledged and personally identified with Jesus.





SUGGESTED PLENARY INDULGENCE OF THE MONTH JUNE 2022

ACT OF REPARATION TO THE SACRED HEART

A partial indulgence is granted the Christian faithful who devoutly recite the above act of reparation. This indulgence will be a plenary one when this Act of Reparation is publicly recited on the solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The prayer is as follows:

Most loving Jesus, how great is the love which you have poured out upon the world. How casual and careless is our response! Kneeling before you, we wish to atone for the indifference and the slights which pierce you to the heart.

R). *Praise to the heart of Jesus, our Savior and our God.*

We ask forgiveness for our own shameful neglect. We wish to make amends for those who are obstinate in their unbelief, for those who turn away from the light and wander like sheep without a shepherd, and for those who have broken their baptismal promises and reject the gentle yoke of your law. R).

We wish to make amends for the sins of our society:

for lust and degradation, for the corruption of the young,

for indifference and blasphemy,

for attacks against your Church,

for irreverence and even sacrilege against Your love in the Blessed Sacrament, and for the public defiance of your law. R).

These are the sins for which you died, but now we share in your atonement by offering on the altar in union with you the living sacrifice you made on the cross, joining to it the sufferings of your Virgin Mother and those of all the saints and the whole church. R).

We promise faithfully, that by your grace we shall make reparation for our own sins, and for those of others by a strong faith, by holy living, and by obedience to the law of the Gospel, whose greatest commandment is that of charity. R).

We also promise to do our best to discourage others from insulting you and bring those we can to follow you. R).

Jesus Lord, receive this loving act of homage together with the prayers of our Lady, who stood by the cross, our model in reparation. Keep us faithful, even to the point of death, give us the gift of perseverance and lead us all to our promised land in heaven, where you, with the Father and the Holy Spirit, live and reign for ever and ever. Amen. R).



FR. EUGENE'S COMMENTARY & SUGGESTION

The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus will be on Friday, June 24. On this day, here at STM, during our 6:00 pm Friday Holy Hour, we will have an opportunity to pray this Act of Reparation. Pope Pius XII described this devotion as follows: "It is altogether impossible to enumerate the heavenly gifts which devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus has poured out on the souls of the faithful, purifying them, offering them heavenly strength, rousing them to the attainment of all virtues. Therefore, recalling those wise words of the Apostle St. James, 'Every best gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of Lights,'" ("Haurietis Aquas: On Devotion to the Sacred Heart").

CONDITIONS FOR RECEIVING A PLENARY INDULGENCE

1. Do the prescribed work.
2. Receive Holy Communion within several days (before or after) of the indulgenced act.
3. Go to confession within several days (before or after) the indulgenced act
4. Pray for the Pope. An Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be can suffice.
5. Be free from attachment to all sin, even venial sin.
6. OTHER NOTES: · In order to be capable of gaining indulgences one must be baptized, not excommunicated, and in the state of grace (free of mortal sin) at least at the completion of the prescribed works. · To gain an indulgence, one must have at least the general intention of doing so and must carry out the enjoined works at the stated time and in due fashion, according to the sense of the grant. · Plenary indulgences can be applied to one's self, or to a person who has died. · Only one plenary indulgence may be obtained per day. · A single sacramental confession suffices for gaining several plenary indulgences; but Holy Communion must be received and prayer for the intention of the Holy Father must be recited for the gaining of each plenary indulgence. · Special exceptions can always be made for those who are sick or disabled in which case please inquire with the priest.
