



#### St. Vincent de Paul Quarterly Report

All of the members of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul for St. Thomas More would like to thank all of the

parishioners who've donated to our ministry. Without your support, we wouldn't have been able to help a number of families keep a roof over their heads, heat their homes, or put food on their tables. As many of you know, rising rents, higher utility bills, and food inflation are making it harder for families to make ends meet, particularly those on fixed incomes, such as Social Security or disability. Unexpected expenses, such as a car repair or medical bill, often put these families in crisis. Thankfully, with your help, we're able to provide meaningful, short-term assistance that prevents families from being evicted, or losing water, gas, or electricity services. In addition, we help them secure food through our food pantry, which is open the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of each month from 12:00pm to 1:00pm at the back of the church.

For the quarter ending June 30, we deployed \$3,664 in rental assistance to help seven families with housing needs. In addition, we deployed \$1,541 to help three families pay their utility bills. And we served an average of forty families at each of our Food Pantries by partnering with Second Harvest of Orange County and supplementing their deliveries at a cost of roughly \$1,310 a month. Other forms of assistance totaled \$356, and we spent \$375 on administrative expenses, such as insurance.

Fortunately, we were blessed with \$10,257 in donations from our parish community, resulting in a surplus of \$391 for the quarter. So, again, we thank you for your generous donations. Without your help, we wouldn't have been able to provide any of this assistance.
