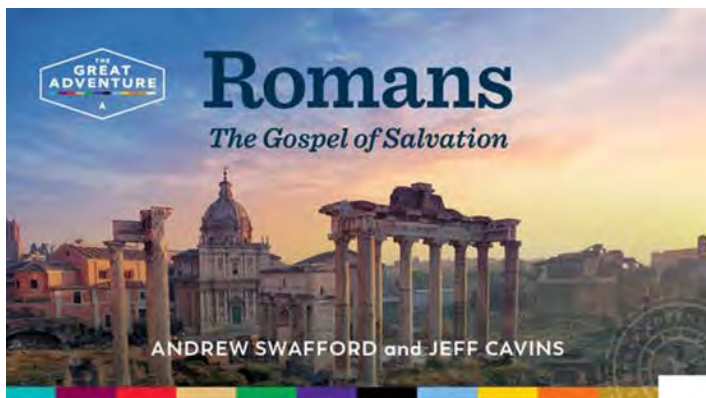

The St Thomas More Parish Library staff would like to wish all our parishioners a Happy 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Parish Library will be open today from 9:00am to 1:00pm.

All holiness is God's holiness in us, to express His love which is given by God to His Church. The holiness of man reveals the true nature of man looking for Christ, who is the true man and true God. Man becomes a truly holy human only when he is united with God, so that the fullness of God will abide in his flesh. If this topic is appealing to you then the STM Parish Library has a remarkable book entitled, '*God and Man*', authored by Archbishop Antony Bloom. Archbishop Antony summarizes the essence of Christian life with five selections: the Atheist and the Archbishop, Doubt and the Christian Life, Man and God, Holiness and Prayer and John the Baptist. On Friday, August 12th and 13th, STM hosted our first ever Campout with the Eucharist. Fr. Eugene Lee, Pastor, along with Tara Reynaud, Director of Adult Faith Formation, and a team of volunteers put together an adventurous, faith-filled night including prayer, food, and small group presentations. Barbara Catiller, Director of Faith Formation, hosted a children's session and Abraham Villela, Director of Confirmation and Youth Ministry, led a reenactment of the Passover Seder Meal. Fr. Eugene gave a thorough explanation of the Eucharist and how he purifies the vessels at the end of Mass. The other station, lead by members of the Devotional Life Committee spoke about Eucharistic Miracles. Later everyone gathered for praise and worship, prayed the rosary and adored Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament during a Holy Hour. Those who were not camping overnight went home, however Eucharistic Adoration continued throughout the night. Those who camped out all night had the opportunity to emerge from their tents to spend time with our Lord in Adoration.
