



JAMAICA MISSION

15 YOUNG ADULTS SERVING THE GHETTOS OF KINGSTON

From August 1-10, Fr. Eugene Lee led a group of 15 young adults from St. Thomas More on a life-changing mission pilgrimage to Kingston, Jamaica. We served alongside the Missionaries of the Poor (M.O.P.), a religious order of consecrated men and women who dedicate their lives to serving the people in their local communities. When our group first arrived, we knew we were coming to serve, but what we did not expect was how profoundly we would be transformed. For ten days, we were warmly welcomed into the rhythm of the communal lifestyle of these M.O.P. Brothers and Sisters: we prayed together, we shared meals together, and we served side-by-side at the different centers, where we met residents whose joy, dignity, and courage will stay in our hearts forever.

A REFLECTION ON OUR PILGRIMAGE

Who are those people whom we met and helped? They are the poorest of the poor, several of whom are afflicted with severe mental illnesses and physical impairments. They are the lowliest, most neglected in our society, yet God called us to come to their assistance. We did not just watch the M.O.P. Brothers and Sisters serve them; we lived as they lived. We fed the poor, washed them, clothed them, spent time with them - no matter what act it was, we did so out of love and nothing else. As a result, we discovered the overwhelming abundance of God's graces that He has prepared for us. We saw up close what it means to love without holding back, to work tirelessly for the most vulnerable, and to see Christ in every person. We overcame our own fears and anxieties, we worked alongside our fellow M.O.P. Brothers and Sisters in joy, and we collectively took care of those who would otherwise have no one else to take care of them. The work we did in itself was a gift from God, and we turned to Him repeatedly throughout the day during each cycle within the Liturgy of the Hours. The fixed times of prayer, accompanied by charitable work in service of the poor, gave us a glimpse and taste of the Kingdom of Heaven, made present to us in Jamaica.





The Missionaries of the Poor continue to live out the Gospel in a way that is not just inspiring, but also contagious. Their mission is to care for the poorest of the poor, not only by meeting physical needs, but by restoring dignity and reminding each person that they are beloved children of God. And in doing so, they have taught us that service is not simply about what we give, but about who we become when we love in action. We came thinking we were bringing help, but we left knowing we have received more than we could ever give. We received lessons in humility, joy, and faith. We learned that community is powerful, that when people live and serve together in the name of God, incredible things happen. I loved watching our dynamic, too. Everyone in our group is so different, yet we all come together so beautifully solely because we are all committed to living out our lives for Christ. That unity was built on shared faith, which is something we will carry home and strive to live out in our own communities.

We carried each and every one of your prayer intentions with us throughout our journey in our Divine Mercy Novena we prayed each night. Even from afar, you were on mission with us. Brothers and Sisters for opening your lives to us, for showing us that true service is rooted in prayer, and for reminding us that the greatest calling we have is to love. Lastly, thank you Fr. Eugene for all that you did to make this trip possible and for being our spiritual father.






Devotions, Explained!







