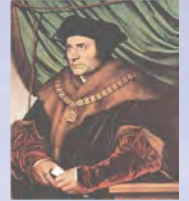

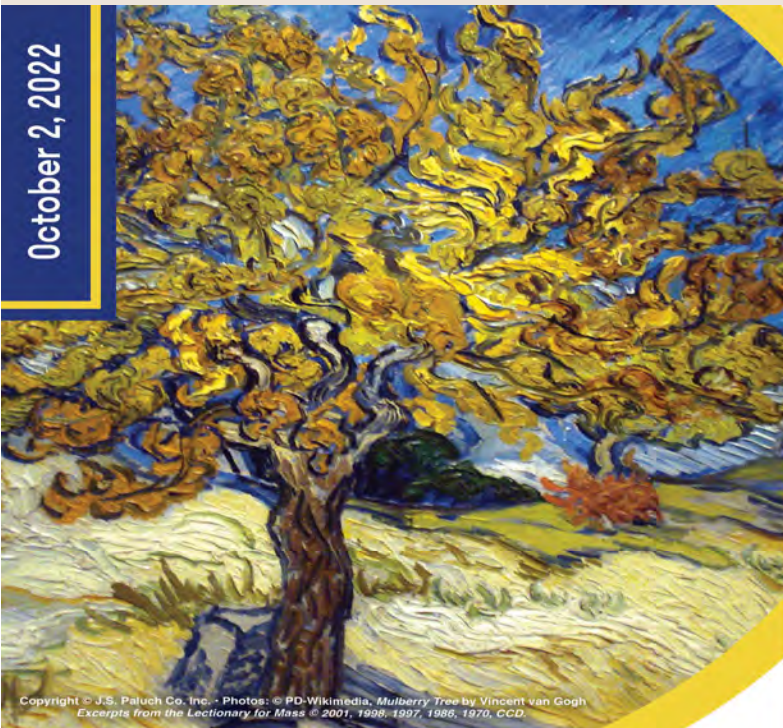

27th Sunday in Ordinary Time
Respect Life Sunday



The St. Thomas More Parish Library staff would like to wish all our parishioners a Happy 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Parish Library will be open today from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm.

Today is Respect Life Sunday, with the whole month of October being dedicated as Respect Life Month. The past Roe v. Wade judgement by the U.S. Supreme Court guaranteed a constitutional right to an abortion, for over fifty years. This decision was recently overturned by the U.S. Supreme Court. The Parish Library has an excellent book on this topic titled, 'Recall Abortion: Ending the Abortion Industry's Exploitation of Women', authored by Janet Morana. Janet exposes the myriad of ways abortion clinics exploit women and how they risk the health and well-being of women, both physically and mentally. Janet also investigates abortion's debilitating after-effects of real suffering, like untold regret, deep depression and long lasting physical and emotional scars. Aborting an unborn baby does not empower a woman, it is not health care, moreover, it severely harms all parties involved.

VOTE "NO" ON PROPOSITION 1

SUGGESTED PLENARY INDULGENCE OF THE MONTH OCTOBER 2022

PRAYERS TO THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

A PLENARY INDULGENCE is granted the Christian faithful who

1. devoutly recite the Marian rosary in a church or oratory, or in a family, a religious community, or an association of the faithful, and in general when several of the faithful gather for some honest purpose;
2. devoutly join in the recitation of the rosary while it is being recited by the Supreme Pontiff and broadcast live by radio or television.

FR. EUGENE'S COMMENTARY & SUGGESTION

October is the Month of the Rosary. Here at St. Thomas More Catholic Church we pray will pray the rosary EVERY DAY during the month of October at 8:00 pm on Zoom! Go to stmirvine.org to find the link to connect on Zoom with everyone. The rosary has power! The rosary shifts history! The rosary protects families! The rosary changes hearts.

CONDITIONS FOR RECEIVING A PLENARY INDULGENCE

1. Do the prescribed work.
2. Receive Holy Communion within several days (before or after) of the indulgenced act.
3. Go to confession within several days (before or after) the indulgenced act
4. Pray for the Pope. An Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be can suffice.
5. Be free from attachment to all sin, even venial sin.
6. OTHER NOTES: · In order to be capable of gaining indulgences one must be baptized, not excommunicated, and in the state of grace (free of mortal sin) at least at the completion of the prescribed works. · To gain an indulgence, one must have at least the general intention of doing so and must carry out the enjoined works at the stated time and in due fashion, according to the sense of the grant. · Plenary indulgences can be applied to one's self, or to a person who has died. · Only one plenary indulgence may be obtained per day. · A single sacramental confession suffices for gaining several plenary indulgences; but Holy Communion must be received and prayer for the intention of the Holy Father must be recited for the gaining of each plenary indulgence. · Special exceptions can always be made for those who are sick or disabled in which case please inquire with the priest.

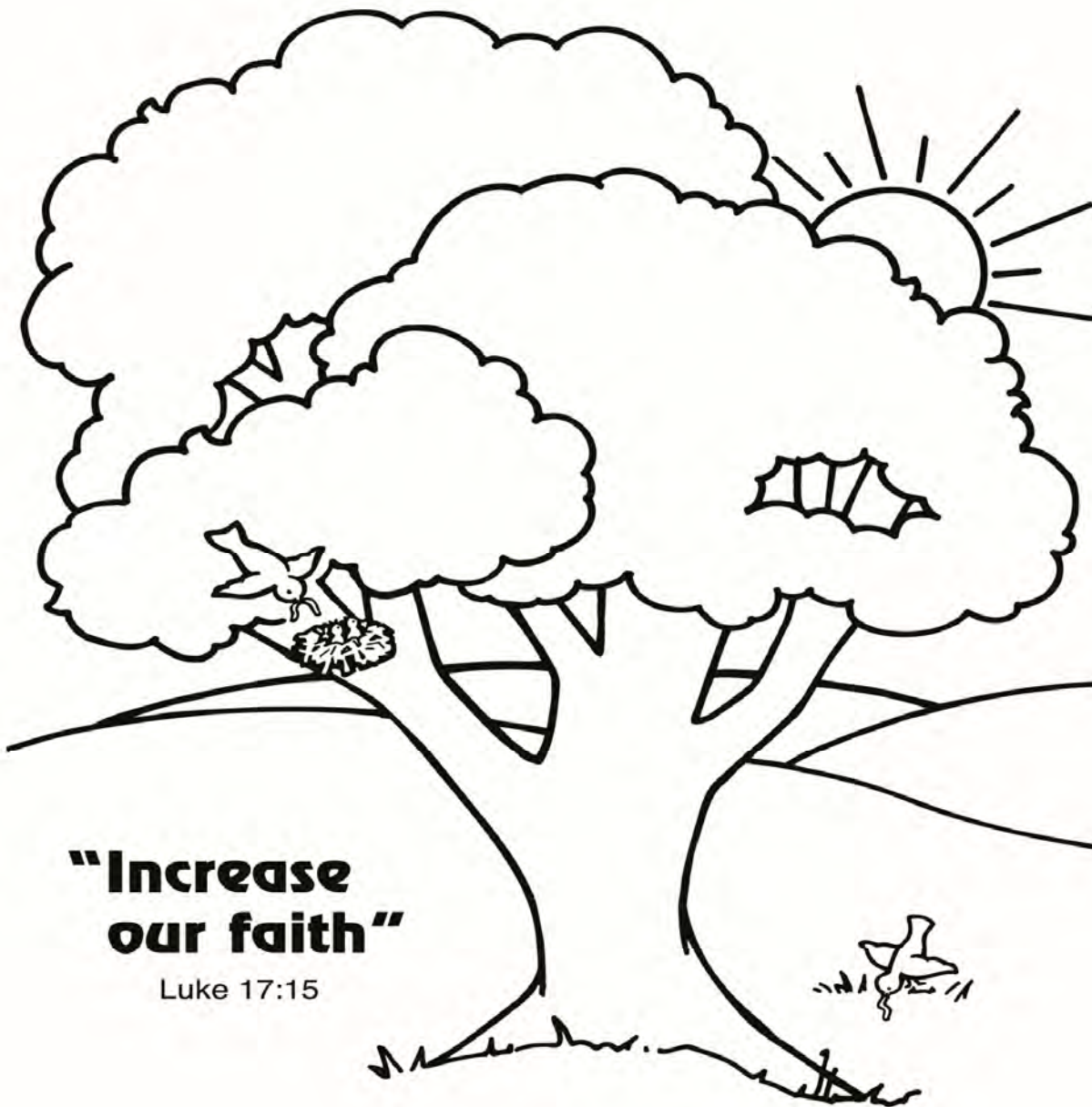
