28<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time



The St Thomas More Parish Library staff would like to wish all our parishioners a Happy 28<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Parish Library will be open today from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm.

Are you interested in learning more about the Sacraments of the Catholic Church? The STM Parish Library has a great book on this topic titled, *'These are the Sacraments'*, authored by Archbishop Fulton John Sheen.

Bishop Sheen analyzes the necessity for the Sacraments and gives an explanation of their origin. He then explains each Sacrament: from the beginning of rebirth at Baptism; to the spiritual strength received at Confirmation, the reception of the Body and Blood of Christ at Holy Communion, the forgiveness of sins at Penance, the blessing of the body in the Anointing of the Sick, the power of Consecration granted through Holy Orders, and the nuptial blessing received through the Sacrament of Matrimony. This is an excellent book to read for those who seek to understand the Sacraments on a deeper level.

**VOTE "NO" ON PROPOSITION 1**

Proposition 1 is a worst-case scenario for abortion in California. It is an expensive and misleading ballot measure that allows unlimited late-term abortions — for any reason, at any time, even moments before birth, paid for by tax dollars. Prop 1 isn't needed. 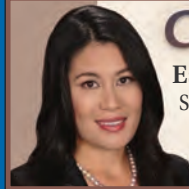
