





The members of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul for St. Thomas More would like to thank all the parishioners and ministries who donated to our ministry in the third

quarter. Without your support, we wouldn't have been able to provide much needed assistance to keep families in their homes, or keep them from losing water, gas, or electricity services. In addition, we help them secure food through our food pantry, which is open the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month from 12:00 to 1:00 pm at the back of the church.


For the quarter ending September 30th, we deployed \$4,590 in rental assistance to help eight families with housing needs. In addition, we deployed \$3,237 to help four families pay their utility bills. And we served an average of thirty five families at each of our Food Pantries by partnering with Second Harvest of Orange County. This is down from roughly fifty families per month due to ICE concerns. In line with this, our monthly pantry expenditures averaged \$1,035.

We were blessed with \$14,204 in donations from our parish community, including \$4,000 from the Knights of Columbus and \$5,000 from the Hispanic Ministry. addition to parish donations, we received a \$5,000 grant from the Orange County Council of St. Vincent De Paul. donations and grant were very much needed. Prior to third quarter, funds were very low, forcing us to pause rent and utility assistance for several weeks. We expect to receive more requests for rent and utility assistance as the economy continues to soften, inflation continues, and we hear of more layoffs. So thank you again. Without your help, we wouldn't have the ability to provide this much needed assistance.

Saint Luke | October 18

Saint Luke, sometimes called The Evangelist, is the author of the third Gospel and the Acts of the Apostles and a physician. There is some debate about how he came to Christianity, though many believe he was a gentile convert. Tradition holds him to be a native of Antioch, Syria, possibly a slave. Most of what we know of Luke comes from Scripture, he was an eloquent and proficient writer, penning with accuracy the events he recounted. He is viewed as one of the best historical sources of the time.

Luke was a close companion of Paul's, joining him at Troas about year 51 and going with him to Macedonia and Philippi. Their paths diverged and

met again as they journeyed to spread the Good News. Luke remained with Paul until the latter was martyred in Rome. Saint Luke's Gospel is viewed as one of social justice, giving special attention to the poor. He also emphasizes gentiles hearing the message of Christ. It is the only Gospel with Mary's Magnificat, and spends the most time illuminating the lives of the other women around Jesus.

Accounts of Luke's death are conflicting, some say he was martyred shortly after Paul others that he lived a long life completing his Gospel in Greece and dying at 84. He is the patron saint of physicians.




