The members of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul for St. Thomas More would like to thank all of the parishioners who've donated to our ministry in the third quarter. Without your support, we wouldn't have been able to help families keep a roof over their heads, heat their homes, or put food on their tables. More and more we're hearing of rents increasing by \$400, \$500 or \$600 per month. This has put a lot of stress on those families that were barely making ends meet as it was, as evidenced by the high number of calls we're receiving for rental assistance. Thankfully, with your help, we're able to provide meaningful, short-term assistance that prevents families from being evicted, or losing water, gas, or electricity services. In addition, we help them secure food through our food pantry, which is open the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month from 12:00 to 1:00 pm at the back of the church.

For the quarter ending September 30, we deployed \$10,168 in rental assistance to help eleven families with housing needs. In addition, we deployed \$1,398 to help three families pay their utility bills. And we served an average of forty families at each of our Food Pantries by partnering with Second Harvest of Orange County and supplementing their deliveries at a cost of roughly \$1,083 a month. Other forms of assistance totaled \$870, and we spent \$385 on administrative expenses, such as insurance.

Fortunately, we were blessed with \$4,449 in donations from our parish community, and a \$5,000 grant from the SVDP's Orange County Council. So, again, we thank you for your generous donations. Without your help, we wouldn't have been able to provide any of this assistance.

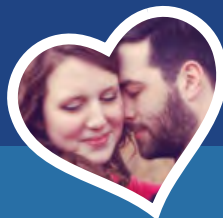
