My dear brothers and sisters,

With immense gratitude, I write to all of you. I am constantly amazed at the generosity of the people of God, and I do not take lightly the duty to be the chief steward of the giftedness that is ours here at St. Thomas More. There is always the constant pressure to save, save, especially with the building project looming. The good financial health of our parish should ultimately translate to shining the light of Christ ever brighter. In this regard, I am not only immensely grateful for the financial gifts to our parish, but to the countless servants who sacrifice so much of their time to help run our events, activities, programs, and ministries here. It is indeed so inspiring to see.

I would also like to say a brief word about our building campaign. As you can see, we are over the \$10 million mark. When will we start our final (hopefully final) push for the capital campaign? January 2024. How much more do we need to raise? \$10 to \$12 million. The more we raise the higher quality we can build. Can we do it? Yes! I have had a few very positive indications from prospective high donors. We also have a potentially game-changing arrangement that we can make with the Diocese. (More on this later --- I hope!) We also see the financial health of our parish, which is good. So, all these factors combined show that we can do this! All I ask is that people prepare their hearts for this final push and even start to budget and save. In the meantime, I want all to know that we have made a lot of progress in assembling a dream team of professionals who will help to ensure the ultimate success that we are all seeking. More on this later!

Ultimately, all our gifts come from our loving God, and we live in gratitude by using all of what he has given to us for the building of his Kingdom.

Dear fellow Parishioners,

On behalf of the STM Finance Council, I am pleased to report the highlights of our parish's financial performance for the 12 months ending June 30th, 2023. Thanks to your generosity, the financial health of the parish continues to be positive. As Father Eugene mentioned, our funds to build our new church has exceeded \$10,000,000. Our cash position remains strong, and any extra cash (over and above the cash required to meet our monthly requirements), has been funneled to the Capital Campaign fund.

Other financial highlights are as follows:

- Sunday collections were up 9%. These funds are essential for the day-to-day running of our parish.

- Expenses were up 21%. Most of these increases were due to inflationary pressures and additional services offered by our ministries.

- Net Income was up 46%, mostly due to a 60% increase in our Capital Campaign revenue.

All in all, our Balance Sheet remains strong, with very little debt. We are extremely grateful for the financial gifts of our parishioners. Your donations enable the parish to continue growing religious programs and services, while patiently preparing for the building of our new church.
