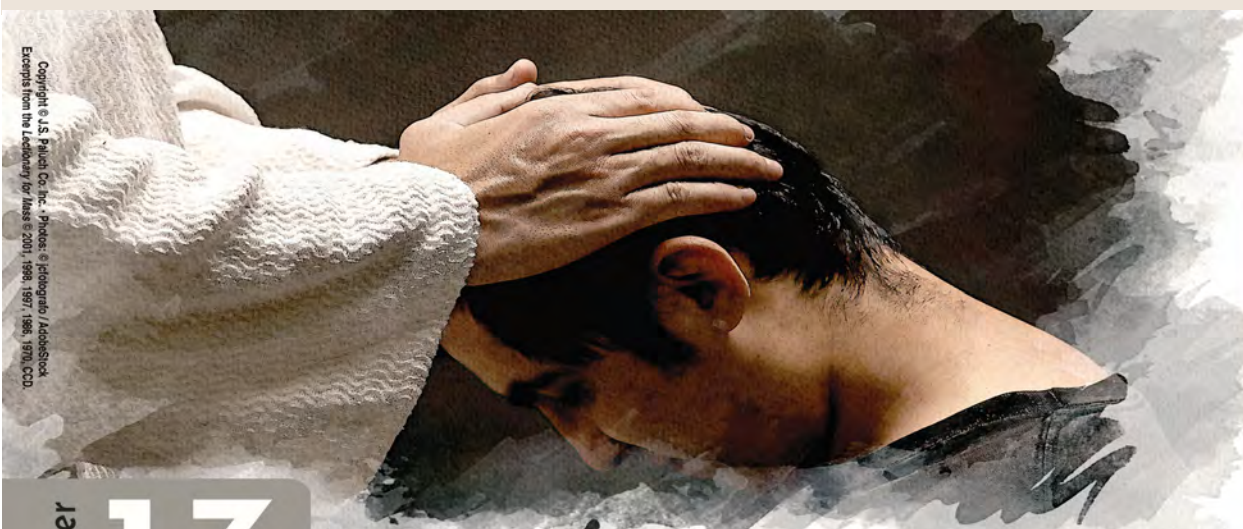


**BE AN ANGEL THIS CHRISTMAS**

The St. Thomas More Parish Library staff would like to wish all our parishioners a Happy 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Parish Library will be open today from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm.

The STM Parish Library has a book for anyone who is interested in learning about the interior journey of their soul. This book will help you gain the beginning of a psychological understanding of the life of the soul, at its various developmental stages, as well as the start of an awareness of the relationship between sin and its causes, processes, development and consequences. This book is entitled, '*Spiritual Passages*', by Father Benedict J. Groeschel. Father Benedict writes as both an instructor and proxy director for this goal, by weaving lessons on the spiritual life with contemporary examples. His approach begins by asking the reader how they hear God and gives four examples; God as one, God as true, God as good and God as beautiful. His next method is by framing the spiritual life into three stages; the purgative (cleansing), the illuminative (enlightening) and the unitive (power of uniting), which shows how each lead to a different kind of spiritual path.

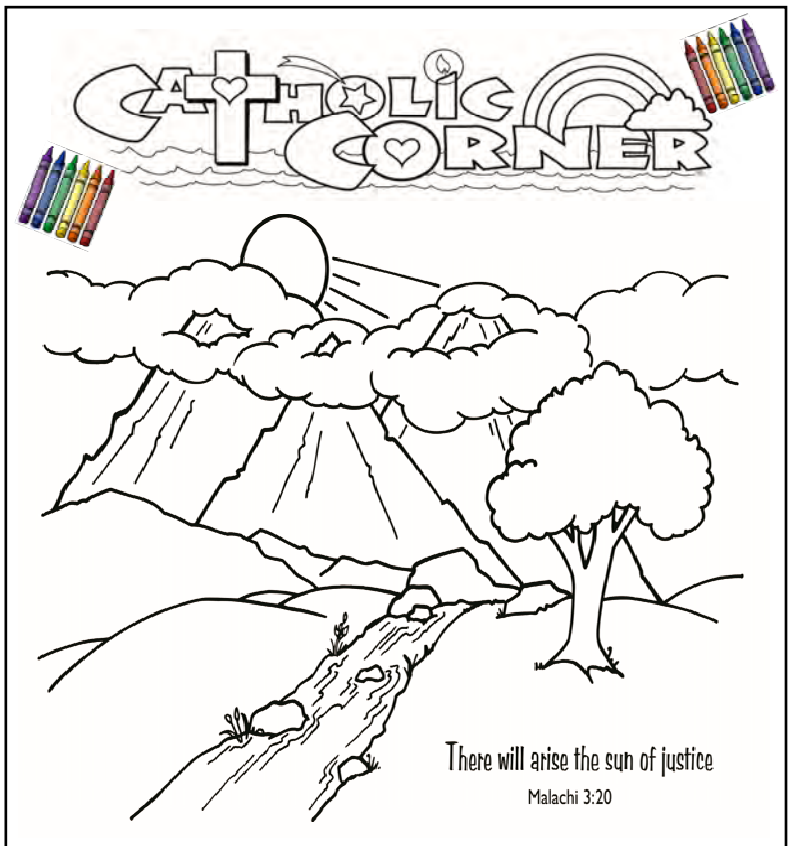

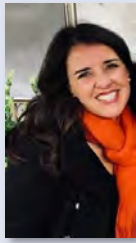

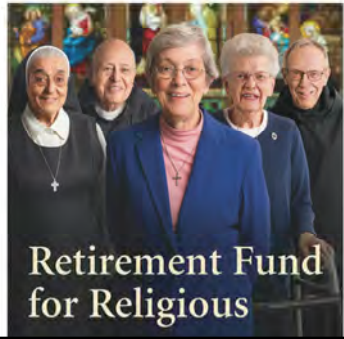
