The Library Corner

The STM Parish Library staff would like to wish all our parishioners a Happy First Sunday of Advent. The Parish Library will be open today from 9am to 1pm.

On December 8th, the Church observes the Feast Day of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This feast celebrates the fact that Mary, the Mother of Jesus, in order to be a most perfect vessel for the Savior, was herself conceived without original sin and without any stain. But do we really know what the Immaculate Conception means? The grace given to Mary is a permanent and a unique gift from God. So, the grace that Mary enjoyed was extended over the whole of her life, from conception onward. She was in a state of sanctifying grace from the first moment of her existence. This feast day was declared in 1854 by Pope Pius IX. There are many references to the Immaculate Conception that may be found in the Bible; Gabriel said. 'Hail, Full of Grace, the Lord is with you'; Mary as 'Woman', alludes to Eve, who is called 'Woman'; Mary as the Woman of the New Creation and Eve as the Woman before the Fall; and the early Church Fathers like Justin Martyr and Irenaeus express solid support of this doctrine. Ave Maria, Gratia Plena, Dominus Tecum. Remember, this is a Holy Day of Obligation.
